## **SOUTHERN GIANT PETREL**

Family Procellariidae
Species Macronectes giganteus
Common name Southern Giant Petrel
Status Native
Abundance Common

Size 800mm – 900 mm (cf sparrow 145 mm, Black-backed Gull 600mm)

Breeding islands close to New Zealand Nearest is at the Macquarie Islands.

Range Found around oceans of the southern hemisphere below latitude 18°.

Discussion The Southern Giant Petrel comes in variable plumages. There is a dark phase, which is similar to the Northern Giant Petrel except for bill colour. There are also white and variable phases showing marked differences.

## Differences between Southern Giant Petrel and Northern Giant Petrel

- Southern has a whitish head and breast or may be all white.
- Southern has yellowish bill.
- Northern has yellowish bill tipped with tan.

## Where to find - South Island

**Kaikoura** – Regularly seen from seabird excursions. P. 289. **Otago** – Often seen offshore along the Otago and Southland coasts. P. 361.
