Campbell Island Shag Leucocarbo campbelli (Filhol 1878) Endemic December 1840 Campbell Island

Robert McCormick recorded this species in December 1840. Dr H. Filhol was the first to distinguish the species, when he visited Campbell Island in October 1874. He was on a French expedition that had the purpose of observing the transit of Venus. Filhol described the species in 1878. Hutton (1878) referred this species to *P. magellanicus*.
