**White Heron** (Kotuku) *Ardea modesta* J.E. Gray 1831, Native 23/4/1773 Dusky Sound, Fiordland May 1892 Norfolk Island

It was first observed by Cook (1777) on his second voyage: "One of the party shot a white hern, which agreed exactly with Mr Pennant's description, in his British Zoology, of the white herns that either now are, or were formerly, in England".

The only New Zealand breeding colony was discovered by Mueller at Okarito, on the banks of the Watangiroto River, in December 1865.
