CHATHAM ISLAND OYSTERCATCHER (H. chathamensis)

Considered a separate, endangered endemic, it is a residential species living on coastal outcrops and sandy beaches, and similar to the pied phase of the Variable Oystercatcher. It has though, a shorter bill and lacks the clean-cut white and black margins of the Pied Oystercatcher.
