Subantarctic Skua (Hakoakoa) *Catharacta antarctica lonnbergi* Mathews 1912, Native
6/10/1769 Pacific Ocean
1911 Norfolk Island
1964 Sabrina Islet, Balleny Islands, Ross Sea (Kinsky 1964)

“Port Egmont Hens” were first recorded by both Cook and Banks on 6/10/1769, 360 nautical miles north of the Chathams. This skua was then collected off Otago on 23/2/1770 (Lysaght 1959; Fleming 1983) or 24/2/1770 by Banks (Cook 1771).

This form was named subspecifically by Mathews in 1912. There is an undated specimen in the British Museum from Norfolk Island (Iredale 1911).
