White-winged Triller *Lalage sueurii* (Vielliot 1818), Vagrant (1)
26/2/1969 MacAndrew Bay, Otago Harbour, Otago

Brian McPherson (1973) found the only one so far recorded, in his garden in Howard Street, MacAndrew Bay. He had heard an unfamiliar song and quickly found the bird in a willow tree. On 1 March, Dr R.F. Smith obtained photographs and a sound recording. Only three people appeared to have seen this bird, which would surely attract a larger audience nowadays. It was last seen on 21st June.
