Red-necked Stint *Calidris ruficollis* (Pallas 1776), Migrant
1866 Manukau, Auckland
August 1967 Norfolk Island

R.B. Sibson (1979) found a painting of this species by Richard Laishley in October 1978 in the British Museum of Natural History. It was labelled “*Charadrius minutus*, Least Dotterel. From the Manukau, N.I. 1866”. The first record was previously thought to be one shot by Edgar Stead, at Lake Ellesmere, in January 1902.
